



The Arboretum's first-ever Next Generation Science Standards Field Study Program!

The Arboretum is currently offering a Next Generation Science Standards Field Study program for 4th and 5th grade classes from Title 1 schools on Wednesday and Thursday mornings from 9:30am-12pm.

The NGSS Field Study Program is 2.5 hours long and includes a guided garden exploration followed by field journaling and hands-on science activities in our designated Education House classroom.

The program can accommodate up to a maximum of 36 students only per day.

To qualify, teachers must agree to complete the pre and post visit activities with their students, complete a program evaluation survey, and submit follow-up documentation to the Education Department within one month of their visit.

The Arboretum will cover the bus transportation costs of those classes that participate. Bus transportation compensation will be issued in the form of a reimbursement check upon receiving all the post-visit materials and evaluations.
